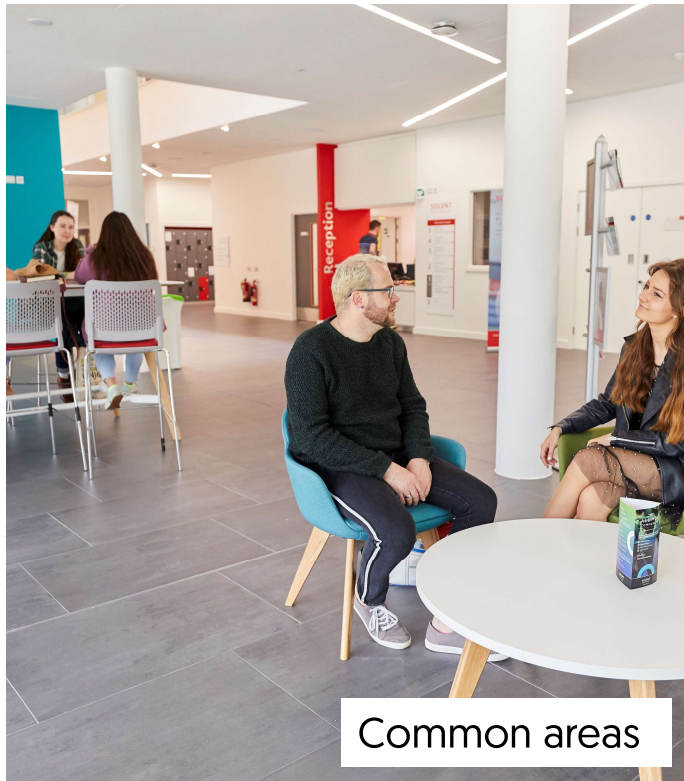

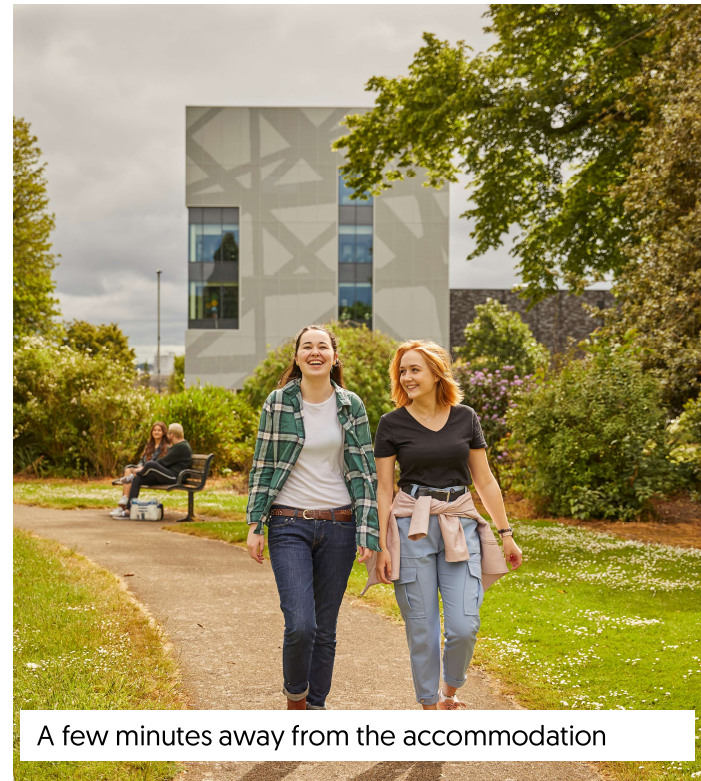




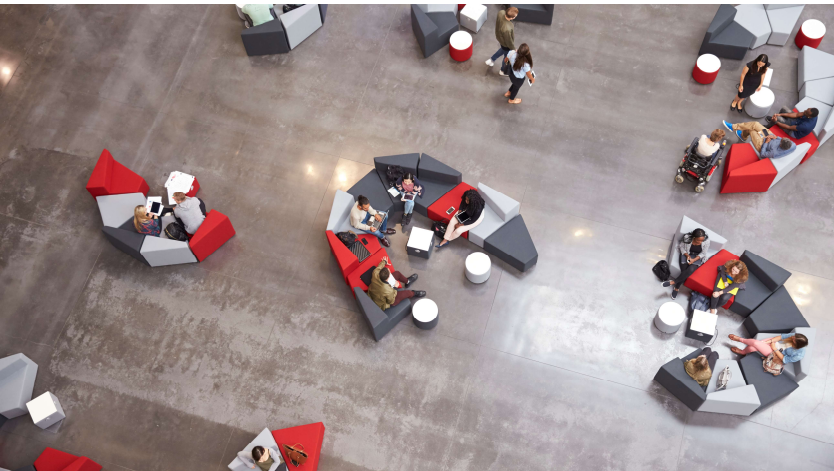

London
